#### **Responsibilities:**

- Implements curriculum for three to five children under the supervision of the Lead Teacher
- Implements lesson plans for individuals and assigned groups
- Assesses group and individual needs in coordination with the Lead Teacher
- Maintains room, supplies and equipment in coordination with Lead Teacher
- Develops positive relationships with the children
- Communicates any problems or concerns regarding the program or children to the Lead Teacher
- Assume other responsibilities as assigned or required

#### **Desired Qualifications:**

- Must be 18 years of age
- GED or High School Diploma
- Child care experience with infants, toddlers, or preschoolers preferred
- Ability to pass criminal history background check
- Must be able to sign our Statement of Faith
- Must be able to lift, reach, bend, twist, push, pull, squat, grasp and use arm-hand coordination on a consistent basis
- Must have the ability to lift up to 40 pounds
