



Family Services Program Youth and Family Advocate and Curriculum Development

**This position supports two aspects of Family Services:
Youth and Family Advocacy – 4 days per week
Curriculum Development – 1 day per week**

Internship position location: Renton, WA

Youth and Family Advocate (YFA) 4 days week

- Participate in family attachment assessment; observe and engage with the program objectives.
- Document and enter data into resident tracking database (ETO).
- Engage with families and volunteers in events, activities and one on one sessions.
- Actively support YFA staff in summer planning, activities, camps and field trips.
- Create Attachment Curriculum and Engagement Tools with demonstrated relevance. (This will be an on-going project through the year, with reflection requirements intended to be part of the intern portfolio).

Curriculum Development, 1 day week

- Attend classes in progress to observe and improve systems.
- Create and/or refine curriculum for the skill building classes available for the residents of Vision House.
- Recruit and train the volunteers to teach the classes.
- Establish an on-going schedule for classes at both Shoreline and Renton sites.
- Create and record pre and post class assessments.
